B Digging Deeper and Application

Key Texts: Genesis 1:26-27 NKJV, Ephesians 2:12-15 NKJV and Acts 17:24-27

- 1. How has this series impacted your life so far?
- God loves diversity. We see in Acts 17:24-27 that God has deliberately made us ethnically different. Some people have tried to distort this truth by quoting the account of Noah in Genesis 9:18-27 and stating that some races were cursed and made inferior to others.
 - Read Genesis 9:18-27 and explain how this myth is not true about Africa.
 - To what extent has this distortion affected you? I.e. do you see yourself as inferior or superior to someone of a different race?
 - How was this myth communicated to you?
 - What Biblical backing can you quote to refute this myth?
- 3. Another myth that has wrongly been propagated is 'God wants the races to remain separate or pure'. Some places like South Africa believed that inter racial marriages is against Gods law. This myth was a misinterpretation of **Deuteronomy 7:3-4.**
 - Explain the correct interpretation of this scripture.
 - Moses married a Cushite and Boaz married a Moabite. What can you learn from these inter-ethnic relationships?

C. Take Home

Let us be careful not to use the Bible to try and defend unbiblical myths. Find out what God says on every matter by always searching scripture for yourself. The word of God never conflicts itself.
