Key Texts NKJV:

Colossians 3:1-2, Philippians 3:18- 20 NLT, 2 Corinthians 5:1-4, Matthew 6:19- 20 and John 12:23- 28.

- 1. In 1 Corinthians 9:24-27 Paul shows how an athlete disciplines himself for an earthly crown.
 - i) What adjustments do you need to make in your life in order for you to run in such a way that you obtain the heavenly crown?
 - ii) What does your heavenly 'score board' look like right now? Read 1 Peter 5:2-4
- 2. Pastor Walker mentioned several ways in which we are to live for heaven while we are still on earth:
 - i) Maintain your heavenly 'tent' **2 Corinthians 5:1-4**
 - ii) Trust God for financial margin. 1 Timothy 6:18 and 2 Corinthians 9:8
 - iii) Lay aside the sins and weights. Hebrews 12:1
 - iv) Lay up your treasure in heaven. Luke 12:21 and Matthew 6:19-20
 - v) Don't waste this life. John 12:23-28

Discuss with the group how you relate to the above and how you will implement each of these points in your life.
