B. Digging Deeper and Application

Key Text: Colossians 2:12 NLT, Matthew 3:16, 1 Corinthians 15:3-4, Acts 8:26-40

- 1. In your own words, explain what biblical baptism is.
- 2. Why is it important for you as a believer to be baptized?
- **3.** The early church clearly modeled how baptism should be conducted. From the account in **Acts 8:26-40**, list down the steps to be taken for baptism.
- **4.** Discuss, with scriptural reference, why the following statements are incorrect:
 - (i) Being baptized is equal to being saved.
 - (ii) I was sprinkled with water on my baptism so I qualify as a baptized Christian.
 - (iii) My parents baptized me as an infant so I don't need to be baptized again.
 - (iv) Baptism washes away my sins.
- **5.** What are the benefits of being baptized? If possible, give examples from your own life?

C. Take Home

Baptism, like Communion is an ordinance that was given to the Church by the Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, as a born again Christian it is necessary that you be water baptized. This week encourage fellow believers who are not yet water baptized to take the step and be baptized.
