

Building Campaign Prayer Points

In preparation for the NextGen building expansion campaign we will be praying for the following praying points over the next number of months within the church prayer groups.

	Prayer Point
1	Thanksgiving for the goodness, mercy, and faithfulness of our God ...and he named it Ebenezer (stone of help), saying, “Thus far the LORD has helped us.” (1 Samuel 7:12)
2	Provision of finances needed to complete the project Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:6-7)
3	Faithfulness by all in completing their pledges to the project So Moses gave the command, and this message was sent throughout the camp: “Men and women, don't prepare any more gifts for the sanctuary. We have enough!” So the people stopped bringing their sacred offerings. Their contributions were more than enough to complete the whole project. (Exodus 36:6-7)
4	Protection and peace throughout the building project God is our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble. Therefore, we will not fear Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth! The Lord of hosts is with us; The God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah. (Psalm 46:1-2, 10-11)
5	Speedy completion of the project So the wall was finished on the twenty-fifth day of the month Elul—just fifty-two days after we had begun...They realized this work had been done with the help of our God. (Nehemiah 6:15-16)
6	Our affections to be set on things above Moreover, because I have set my affection on the house of my God, I have given to the house of my God, over and above all that I have prepared for the holy house, my own special treasure of gold and silver... (1 Chronicles 29:3)
7	Unity among the building committee for the duration of project At one time all the people of the world spoke the same language and used the same words. But the Lord came down to look at the city and the tower the people were building. 6 “Look!” He said. “The people are united, and they all speak the same language. After this, nothing they set out to do will be impossible for them!” (Genesis 11:1,5-6)
8	Wisdom among MKids teams to navigate safe movements of kids and parents at drop-off and pick-up during construction Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business; but we will give ourselves continually to prayer and to the ministry of the word.” (Acts 6:3)
9	Supernatural wisdom amongst everyone involved in this project in order to construct a building which will meet the current and future needs of the children All these men understood the signs of the times and knew the best course for Israel to take. (1 Chronicles 12:32)
10	Resources and Provision Financial Provision: Pray for God to provide the necessary funds for the building project. Generous Hearts: Ask that God stirs the hearts of the congregation to give generously and sacrificially.

11	<p>Construction and Safety</p> <p>Smooth Construction: Pray for a smooth building process, free from delays or complications.</p> <p>Safety for Workers: Ask for the safety of all workers involved in the construction.</p> <p>“Commit to the Lord whatever you do, and he will establish your plans.” (Proverbs 16:3)</p> <p>“The Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.” (Psalm 121:8)</p>
12	<p>Long-Term Vision</p> <p>Sustainability: Pray for long-term sustainability of the church’s ministries within the new building.</p> <p>Future Generations: Seek God’s blessing on future generations who will use the space for worship and ministry.</p> <p>“Unless the Lord builds the house, the builders labor in vain.” (Psalm 127:1)</p> <p>“The righteous man walks in his integrity; his children are blessed after him.” (Proverbs 20:7)</p>
13	<p>Spiritual Growth</p> <p>Spiritual Awakening: Pray for spiritual growth and awakening within the church during this campaign.</p> <p>Discipleship: Ask that the campaign inspires deeper discipleship and commitment among the congregation.</p> <p>“Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you?” (Psalm 85:6)</p> <p>“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.” (Matthew 28:19)</p>
14	<p>Community Impact</p> <p>Outreach Opportunities: Pray that the new building will serve as a hub for outreach and community service.</p> <p>Neighboring Relationships: Ask for favour and positive relationships with the surrounding community.</p> <p>“You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden.” (Matthew 5:14)</p> <p>“Let each of us please his neighbor for his good, to build him up.” (Romans 15:2)</p>
