



SERMON SERIES: Anointed

SERMON TITLE: Serve One Another

KEY TEXT (NKJV): Exodus 30:30 NKJV

OTHER TEXTS (NKJV, ESV): Matthew 16:16-20, Luke 4:16-22, John 3:34, Acts 10:38, Ephesians 4:7; 4:16, 1 Corinthians 12:29, 1 Peter 4:10.

Big Idea: Anointing is God's way of marking ordinary people for extraordinary heavenly purposes. Throughout Scripture, when someone was anointed, it meant that God had chosen them, set them apart, and filled them with His presence and power to accomplish His will. From Jacob's stone at Bethel, to the tabernacle, to priests and kings, anointing signified "heaven touching people on earth." This anointing finds its fullness in Jesus Christ, the Messiah, the Anointed One, who carried God's fullness and power to bring salvation, healing, and freedom to all people. Through the Holy Spirit, believers now carry God's anointing in measure, called to understand how to walk in it, work with it, and allow it to shape their lives so that God's good purposes can be fulfilled on the earth.

In the second sermon in the series, Ps Walker teaches that believers are anointed by the Holy Spirit to actively express heaven on earth by serving others, advancing God's purposes, and setting people free through the grace and power of Christ.

Exodus 30:30 NKJV

And you shall anoint Aaron and his sons, and consecrate them, that they may minister to Me as priests.

A. Start Talking: Zonal Outreach 2026

In what ways can you intentionally make outreach a daily lifestyle beyond special seasons or church programs, and what practical steps will you take this week to share God's Word and show His love through acts of service?

B. Start Thinking

1. Considering **Luke 4:16-22 NKJV**, share specific ways in which you personally experienced Jesus bringing healing and restoration in your life?
2. How are you using the anointing God has placed on your life to undo the works of the enemy to bring healing and freedom in other people's lives? Read **Acts 10:38 NKJV**.
3. Read **1 Corinthians 12:29-31 NKJV**. How can you overcome the temptation to compare yourself with others and instead embrace and faithfully serve in the unique gift and role God has given you in the Body of Christ?

C. Start Doing

1. **Recognise** that you are anointed by the Holy Spirit not just to know God, but to actively serve His purposes by bringing healing, hope, and freedom to others.
2. **Align** your gifts and grace with God's agenda by doing your part in the Body of Christ, faithfully using what He has entrusted to you for the edification of others.
3. **Yield** daily to the Holy Spirit's empowerment so that, like Jesus, you can go about doing good and confronting oppression with love, truth, and compassion.
4. **Commit** to being a good steward of God's varied grace by intentionally using your anointing to preach, heal, restore, and set people free in the sphere He has placed in you.

D. Start Praying (Pray as a group during the meeting)

1. **Group Prayer:** Pray that the Lord will help you to yield to His anointing and faithfully act on it by bringing healing, freedom, and hope to the people He has placed in your life, just as Jesus did (**Acts 10:38 NKJV**).
2. **Church Prayer:** Excellence
We honour God through excellent attitudes, words, and actions, valuing one another and setting godly standards that reflect His Kingdom and bring Him glory (**Colossians 3:23 NKJV**).
