

THE LORD ALWAYS KEEPS HIS PROMISES

SERMON TITLE: The Lord Always Keeps His Promises

KEY TEXT (NIV): Psalm 145:8-13

OTHER TEXTS (NKJV, NLT, MSSG): Psalm 145:13b, Deuteronomy 7:9, Hebrews 6:12, Hebrews 10:23, Hebrews 11:11

Big Idea: The Lord is a faithful, gracious, and compassionate God who never fails to keep His promises. From generation to generation, His covenant remains secure, and everything He has spoken will come to pass. Since God's character is unchanging and trustworthy, our confidence is not in circumstances or timelines, but in who He is. As believers, we are called to place our faith not only in God but also in His promises, holding firmly to our confession of hope, exercising patience, and refusing to grow weary. We must wait with assurance, live with confidence, and declare His faithfulness until every promise is fulfilled.

In this sermon, Ps Walker teaches us to strengthen our faith in God's unchanging character so that we can confidently trust, confess, and patiently hold on to His promises, knowing that the Lord is always faithful to fulfill what He has spoken.

Psalm 145:8-13 NIV

*The Lord is gracious and compassionate,
slow to anger and rich in love.*

The Lord is good to all.

He has compassion on all he has made.

*All your works praise you, Lord;
your faithful people extol you.*

*They tell of the glory of your kingdom and speak of your might,
so that all people may know of your mighty acts and the glorious splendor of your kingdom.
Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom,
and your dominion endures through all generations.*

Leader Heads-Up: Happy New Year, CG Family! Every person matters. A quick check-in, with those present and **not**, can help someone feel seen and remembered. Make every meeting warm, welcoming, and memorable.

A. Start Talking: Zonal Outreach 2026

As we begin the year, what Outreach initiatives or community needs have you identified, and what opportunities exist for long-term collaboration to enhance their effectiveness and impact?

B. Start Thinking

1. What fears, doubts, or past experiences make it hard for you to believe that God always keeps His promises? How will **Psalm 145:13 NIV** help you overcome that doubt?
2. Read **Deuteronomy 7:9 NKJV**. Knowing that God is faithful to keep His covenant for a thousand generations, how does this assurance shape the way you live today, especially in your decisions, priorities, and relationships?
3. Share a time when God was faithful and fulfilled His promise in your life. How does reflecting on these experiences strengthen your faith today? Read **Hebrews 11:11 NKJV**.

C. Start Doing

1. **Trust** God's character by anchoring your faith in who He is rather than what you see.
2. **Hold** fast to God's promises with patience, even when fulfillment seems delayed.
3. **Align** your confession with God's Word, declaring His faithfulness without wavering.
4. **Live** confidently in obedience, knowing that the faithful God will fulfill every promise He has made.

D. Start Praying (Pray as a group during the meeting)

1. **Group Prayer:** Pray that you will trust God and hold fast to your confession without wavering, knowing that He is faithful to keep every promise He made (**Hebrews 10:23 NKJV**).

2. **Church Prayer: We value Biblical Authority and Instruction**

We believe that the Bible is the inspired, unalterable, unchangeable Word of God. Therefore, we will equip disciples with sound doctrine, always relying on the Bible as our first and final authority (**2 Timothy 3:16-17 NKJV; 2 Timothy 4:2 NKJV**).
