

The Key to Human Flourishing

SERMON TITLE: The Key to Human Flourishing

KEY TEXT (NKJV): Psalm 92:1-15 ESV

BIG IDEA: Psalm 92, uniquely titled a song for the Sabbath, serves as a timeless blueprint for today's believer, reminding us that making God's expectations a priority is the true beginning of human flourishing. After six days filled with work demands, digital distractions, family responsibilities, and personal pursuits, Sunday worship calls us to intentionally realign our hearts, not drifting casually into God's presence but deliberately placing Him first. The Psalm redirects us from productivity to praise, from self-focus to God-focus, teaching us that it is good to give thanks, to sing, and to proclaim His steadfast love as a settled rhythm of life. It contrasts the fleeting success of those who ignore God with the deep-rooted, enduring flourishing of those planted in His presence, showing us that lasting fruitfulness does not come from chasing visibility or quick results, but from prioritising worship, remaining anchored in His righteousness, and rooting our lives in the unchanging Rock.


In this sermon, Pastor Moffat encourages believers to prioritise God above all else by rooting their lives in steadfast worship and faithful obedience so that they may experience true and lasting flourishing in Him.

Psalm 92:1-15 ESV

*It is good to give thanks to the Lord, to sing praises to your name, O Most High; to declare your steadfast love in the morning, and your faithfulness by night, to the music of the lute and the harp, to the melody of the lyre.
For you, O Lord, have made me glad by your work; at the works of your hands I sing for joy. How great are your works, O Lord! Your thoughts are very deep! The stupid man cannot know; the fool cannot understand this: that though the wicked sprout like grass and all evildoers flourish, they are doomed to destruction forever; but you, O Lord, are on high forever. For behold, your enemies, O Lord, for behold, your enemies shall perish; all evildoers shall be scattered. But you have exalted my horn like that of the wild ox; you have poured over me fresh oil. My eyes have seen the downfall of my enemies; my ears have heard the doom of my evil assailants.
The righteous flourish like the palm tree and grow like a cedar in Lebanon. They are planted in the house of the Lord; they flourish in the courts of our God. They still bear fruit in old age; they are ever full of sap and green, to declare that the Lord is upright; he is my Rock, and there is no unrighteousness in him.*

A. Start Talking: Prayer Drive February 2026

As we commit to finishing the CG Prayer Drives strong, share what impact it had on you?

B. Start Thinking

1. In what area of your life do you need to choose to obey God, even if it looks like others are succeeding by doing wrong? Read **Psalm 92:12 ESV**.
2. What practical steps will you take to remain spiritually fruitful, especially if you are in a difficult or later stage of life, so that your life continues to reproduce faith in others? Read **Psalm 92:14 ESV**.
3. How will you intentionally structure your week to prioritise and practice heartfelt praise to God, turning Sunday (and daily life) into a rhythm of gratitude rather than grumbling? Read **Psalm 92:1 ESV**.

C. Start Doing

1. **Intentionally** place God first in your weekly schedule, ensuring that worship is not squeezed in, but built in.
2. **Choose** to express gratitude daily, declaring God's steadfast love instead of dwelling on pressure or problems.
3. **Commit** to spiritual disciplines, prayer, scripture, and fellowship that plant your life firmly in God's presence rather than shallow success.
4. **Invest** your time and energy in what produces eternal impact, trusting God for slow, steady growth instead of quick results.

D. Start Praying (Pray as a group during the meeting)

1. **Corporate Church Prayer:** Pray that we will all be deeply rooted in God's Word, growing strong and resilient in faith, bearing fruit in every area of life, remain steadfast in His love and purpose, and may we flourish as a community that glorifies only God. (**Psalms 92 NKJV**)
